The Pontiac Kappa League is a community-based organization of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., open to young men from the Southeast Michigan tri-county metropolitan area in grades 6 - 12. The Pontiac Kappa League, comprised of both Junior (grades 6-8) and Senior (grades 9-12) levels places specific emphasis on promoting leadership development, self-motivation and, self-confidence. This, to foster a never-ending desire for both academic and subsequent career achievement.

The fundamental purpose of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. is achievement. Thus, the primary charge of the Pontiac Alumni Chapter's Kappa League Committee is to mentor and encourage young men in achieving worthy goals for themselves, along with instilling an awareness in them to make constructive contributions to their communities when leadership roles ultimately become their responsibility.

Through various club-oriented activities, workshops and, community service projects, the officers and members of the Pontiac Kappa League participate in activities which expose them to the significance of planning, execution, reporting of / sharing creative ideas, and good leadership characteristics. All activities and workshops are designed to raise their personal aspiration levels and are based in one or more of the following seven phases:

- Phase I** **Self Identity/Purpose** - Discipline, Assurance, Awareness, & Appearance
- Phase II** **Training** - Academic, Career-Choice, Preparation, and Organization
- Phase III** **Competition** - Politics, Career Advancement, and Sports
- Phase IV** **Social** - Religion, Arts, Entertainment, Conversation/Communication, and Etiquette/Manners
- Phase V** **Health Education** - Physical Fitness, Sex Education, Drug Education, and Health and Safety
- Phase VI** **Economic Empowerment & Education** - Stock Market, Fundamentals of Banking, Earning, Saving, Spending, Cash vs. Credit
- Phase VII** **College & Career** - Academic Readiness, High School & Beyond, Career Day, College Admissions, Financial Aid Workshops, Survival Skills

How do I know if I am a member of the Kappa League?

You will receive a letter explaining your candidacy as a member. The letter will also list a few instructions regarding your necessary requirements to be confirmed as a member.

How much does the Kappa League Program Cost?

Kappa League Program dues for the 2021 – 2022 school year may be \$25.00. The Kappa League Program is self-funded, many activities or programs may be sponsored or subsidized. On an average, each Kappa Leaguer may spend from \$150.00 and up throughout the year.

How is the Kappa League Program funded?

Kappa League is self-funded through fundraisers that are planned and executed by the Kappa League Program. Depending on the amount of funds available to sponsor activities will determine the level of activities.

Do I have to reapply each year for the Kappa League Program?

No, once you are confirmed as a member, and maintain active membership, you will not have to reapply each year. Your membership may continue until you graduate from high school.

What reasons would disqualify me from the Kappa League Program?

A Kappa Leaguer can be excluded from the program by violating the Bylaws, Article IV - Participation Requirements. Other reasons may include parental request, probationary status violation, or inappropriate behavior. In the event that your membership has been terminated, you may re-apply the following year.

How long does the Kappa League Program run each year?

The Kappa League Program normally begins in September and runs through June of the following year. However, due to the leadership camp, and new member requirements, the year may begin earlier for new members.
